VISAS

The Liberian travel visa required for this trip are offered at a fee of \$131.00. The Liberian Consulate in Atlanta, Georgia will assist in processing visas for all travelers, if needed, and will host travel clinics in the Summer of 2012. INOCULATIONS

All travelers must obtain a prescription for malarial prophylaxis medication prior to travel from their primary care physician. Certain of these medications need to be started 1-2 weeks prior to the travel date. The following are required vaccinations, which need to be completed as soon as possible:

- Yellow fever vaccine (**required**)
- Typhoid vaccine (**recommended**)
- Meningococcal vaccine (**recommended**)

You may call your area travel clinic for information on all other inoculations.

- Form of government: Multi-party democracy
- Head of state and of government: President Ellen Johnson Sirleaf
- Location: The Atlantic coast of West Africa, bordering Sierra Leone, Guinea, and Cote d'Ivoire; lies between latitudes 4° and 9°N, and longitudes 7° and 12°W.
- Surface area: 111,370 sq km, of which land is 96,320 sq km
- Climate: Tropical. Dry season November to April. Wet season May to October.
- Temperature range: 20-30°C (68-86°F)
- Time zone: Greenwich Mean Time (GMT)
- Population: 3.955 million (2009)
- Religions: Traditional African 40 percent, Christian 40 percent, Muslim 20 percent
- Official Language: English (spoken by 90 percent of the population)
